There is a huge variety of animals at Noah's Ark. Look at some of the pictures and names of them and try to find them. Draw a line to connect the name to the picture.

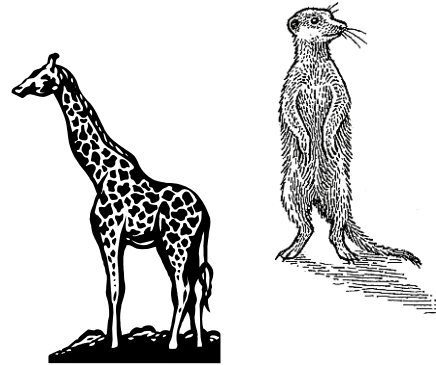

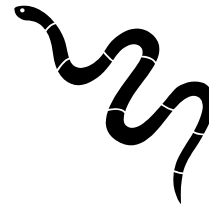

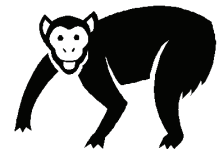

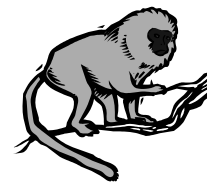

Use the information below and the signs near the animals to decide which group each one fits into (it might be more than one). Write the right letter next to each animal.

V for vertebrates These animals have a backbone.

I for invertebrates These animals don't have a backbone but they might have a shell or a hard exoskeleton.

B for bird These animals have feathers and they lay eggs.

R for reptile These animals have scales on their bodies and most lay eggs.

M for mammal These animals have hair or fur on their bodies and most give birth to live young. See if you can see a young mammal feeding from its mother.

A for amphibian These animals have cold skin without hair or fur and they live in and out of water. They lay eggs.

Can you find any other animals that fit into these groups?
