ANSWERS: 1. As a toilet! 2. Guinea pig. 3. 6ft 4. Warm woolly undercoat, top coat of straight, hollow, tubular hairs which provide insulation from cold and buoyancy in water. Large spreading feet for walking and digging. 5. As small as a grain of rice! 6. Scorpion venom. 7. By backing into them and leaving their quills embedded in them, causing pain or infection. 8. Mainly fruit, seeds and insects; but will also eat carrion (dead things), small birds and mammals. 9. Bite, some flick their hairs into the face of creatures that pose a threat. 10. Puff up, hiss, and stick out its blue tongue to startle a predator!
